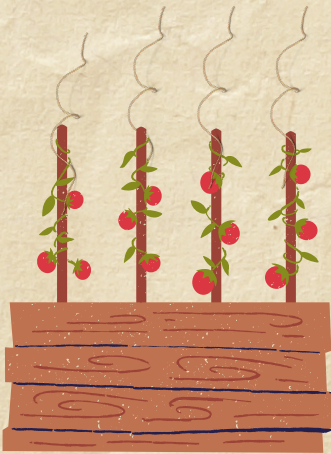
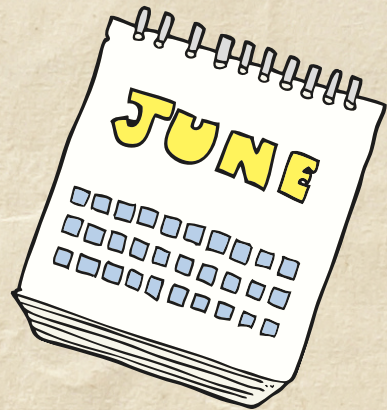

Traditionally tomatoes are grown on a single main stem. This is achieved by using a cane stick, or length of string dangling from something to tie the main stem to.
